Mission Statement

THE MALIA PASTORAL COUNCIL:

The members of the Pastoral Council have been selected. It cannot be stated too frequently that the primary role of a Pastoral Council is to assure the fidelity of the parish to the Mission Statement (see on the left hand corner of every bulletin) and to keep a Pastoral Plan that flows from the Mission Statement and is constantly updated to meet changing circumstances. While the five members of the Standing Committees are members of the Pastoral Council "ex officio", it is their responsibility to assist in the review and update of EVERY segment of the Pastoral Plan, not just the section of the Plan that pertains to their committee. As Sharon Chiarucci, Diocesan Director of Parish Resources, has often stated, "If the directors of the various parish committees are "ex officio" members of the Pastoral Council, they need to take off their hat as chairperson of their committee when they are participating in a Pastoral Council Meeting. They are there, like the other committee members, not to represent a 'special interest' but to assure the good of the entire parish". In our little parish, we have chosen to have the chairpersons of the five standing committees "ex officio" members because they should have their finger on the pulse of the entire parish, not just the area that their committee represents. We have written to Sharon Chiarucci and have asked her to conduct a one day workshop for all the members of the Pastoral Council so that the entire council will "get off on the right foot".

We are very grateful for the number of people who nominated themselves or others to be members of the Pastoral Council. Each person nominated would have been a wonderful person to be on the Council. There were 12 people nominated. We chose four so that the total number comprising the Malia Pastoral Council will be nine. Those chosen were Samantha Naipo-Arsiga, Kehau Kuewa, Dennis McCartin, and Haley Rosehill. Samantha Naipo-Arsiga has consented to be the chairperson and Kehau Kuewa has consented to be secretary. 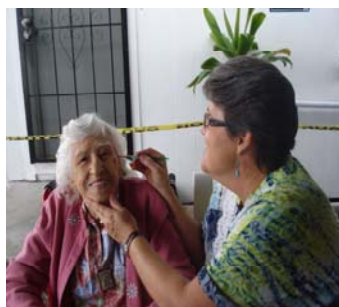
COPIES OF FR. JOE’S REFLECTION ON A TRIP TO KALAUPAPA:
