My blood work is close to perfect and there is no sign of the live leukemia virus in me. While there is no cure for leukemia, remission can last for months, years, or a lifetime. I am deeply grateful to each and all of you for continuing to remember me to the Lord. I love you and you will be forever in my heart.

The doctor still wants to see me every couple months or so for an evaluation. My hope is to come to Hawaii at the end of August to speak to the bishop to determine my future. May God bless all of you.
