## WITH ASH WEDNESDAY WE START OUR JOURNEY TO EASTER:

My Dear Friends,

I do not know if it is because we are becoming old or some other reason, but time flies always faster.

Not long ago we celebrated a great salvation mystery: the Incarnation (Christmas) and now we are going to start the preparation for another salvation mystery: Easter!

February 21<sup>st</sup> is Ash Wednesday. The imposition of the ashes – an ancient, but not antiquated rite – has a transcendental message: God is capable of taking life from death and resurrection from the ashes, as the stem sprouts from the grain that died in the furrow.

In the same way as Adam's clay that became a living being thanks to God's breath, today's clay, by the power that resurrected Jesus from the tomb, is destined for the new and perennial Paschal life.

I invite you to assume with great piety, that is not sorrow, but joyful hope this time of preparation for the feast of resurrection in our Lord's Easter.

**The Mass this Ash Wednesday will be at 6:00PM with the distribution of the Ashes.**

## CHRISM MASS:

Thursday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 7:00PM, we will have Chrism Mass, presided by Bishop Larry Silva and concelebrated by all the priests of the Big Island in the Parish of our Lady of Lourdes in Honokaa.

In this Eucharist the holy oils will be consecrated (Oil of the Sick, Oil of Catechumens and the Holy Chrism) that will be used during the whole year for the different sacraments.

Also, all the priests will make the annual renewal of our priestly vows before the Bishop. At the same time an invitation is made to strengthen the communion of our Diocese by means of the presence of some worshipers from all the parishes.

We are all invited to participate in this Eucharist!



**RITE OF ELECTION:**

Next Sunday, February 26<sup>th</sup>, at 2:00PM, we will have the **Rite of Election** during the Liturgy of the Word in the Annunciation Church, Waimea. The Rite of Election for catechumens is a special ceremony where the adults and youths that have received special preparation to be baptized in our Church during the Paschal Vigil are welcomed.

We invite all that want to participate in this Liturgy of the Word to accompany our candidates for the Sacrament of Baptism.

**HOLY STATIONS OF THE CROSS:**

A practice that is recommended during lent, aside from fasting, prayer and alms giving, is the Holy Stations of the Cross, therefore we are going to have Mass every Wednesday at 5:15PM, and every Monday and Friday at 5:15PM we will pray the Stations of the Cross, followed by Holy Communion
