FINANCE COMMITTEE SUMMARY 6/23/12:

On June (June) 23, 2012 we met on upcoming Budget for fiscal year 2012 – 2013.. The committee successfully reviewed changes in priority of Income vs Expenses based on the history for the past fiscal year 2011-2012. The amount of \$ 130, 700.00 for the next fiscal year of 2012 - 2013. The finance committee confirmed that we are real tight on income against expense.

We have been doing very good Sunday collections thanks to you, since we had a goal of \$77,600.00 and we reached \$81,175.20, but when we added together our expenses we were still \$2,000.00 short for fiscal year 2011-2012. This is in part due to the fact that we have not yet rented our school, and that the Diocese has placed new rules for the rental of installations in all parishes.

The required things from the Diocese have increased: support the parish priest, Financial System: Budget \$780 (52690) and Budget a 10% increase as an estimate for property/liability insurance.

Hardest hit areas from our Parish is Maintenance and Repair will have a \$ 1, 000.00 Budget with the exception of emergency repairs. Liturgy is also taking a cut in not having anyone attend BILAC this year. All this could change if we start getting other revenue for this fiscal 2012 – 2013. Every area has taken a cut and our committees have done an awesome challenge with funds.

The next item were fundraisers:

1. HALL RENTAL
2. SCHOOL RENTAL TO JOYLAND – Laverne Costa brought us up to date as the progress is still in the hands of DHHL Land Management.
3. SWEETBREAD SALES
4. MALASADA SALE
5. HAWAIIAN PLATE DINNER

This is your look of a very busy committee trying to find revenue to keep our PARISH running of MALIA PUKA O KALANI. The community that makes a difference in making all who walk in the doors are all OHANA!
