**PRO-LIFE WEEKEND:** January 22 is the anniversary of Roe vs Wade, the day the Courts ruled that abortion is legal in the United States. The Catholic Church stands as morally opposed to abortion. They are going to eat malasadas on Mardi Gras anyway, so they may as well eat the best in town made at Malia.
