## ***R.I.P. DEACON JERRY***

The Masses this weekend are being offered as a prayer that God will give Deacon Jerry Nunogawa eternal rest and give his dear wife, Rose, and their two sons the peace of Christ. We share their shock and sadness with them. They and we have been given a cross which has not been requested and is not welcome. We are consoled by the words of Jesus, "Come to me all you who are troubled and heavily burdened and I will give you rest".

Recently, Pope Francis stated, "The spirit leads us into the divine life as true children of God, as sons and daughters in the only-begotten Son, Jesus Christ. Are we open to the Holy Spirit? Do we let ourselves be guided by Him? Christians are 'spiritual'. This does not mean that we are people who live 'in the clouds', far removed from real life, as if it were some kind of mirage. No! The Christian is someone who thinks and acts in everyday life according to God's will, someone who allows his or her life to be guided and be nourished by the Holy Spirit, to be a full life, a life worthy of true sons and daughters".

The Pope could have ended his brief comments by stating, "And a good example of this is Deacon Jerry Nunogawa, who I will soon take to myself". Jerry was a proud veteran (did you notice that everytime Jerry was deacon at the Mass he always lead us in a prayer for the soldiers who are still in active duty?). He was a retired employee from the Health Department, a faithful and loving husband, a proud parent of two sons, and a doting grandpa. In the Pope's words, Jerry did not live "in the clouds".

At Jerry's diaconate ordination on Feb 3, 2007, Bishop Larry said, "And so it will be essential for you, Jerry, to contemplate not just what you will do. But even more, what God has called you to be. You must find the time, take the time, even steal the time, if necessary to go apart and pray so that you can listen to God's voice and thus become not just a servant, but a living sacrament of Christ Himself, the servant of all".

The Friday before his death, I asked Jerry to preach at the weekend Masses at Malia on the first weekend of July. He joyfully consented. Jerry will preach on that weekend and for a long time ahead by having been the gift of himself to us, a human witness of the words of both Pope Francis and Bishop Larry. May you rest in peace, dear friend, and may God watch over those who will always love you. ***Fr. Joe***
