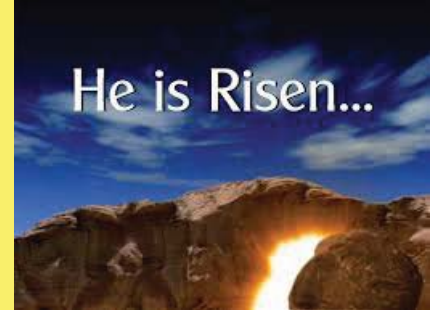
**Dear Parishioners and Guests,**

The celebration of Easter at Malia is a family celebration directed to the participation of the children. We will see and talk about butterflies, Easter eggs, and hapu'u. These are all images that give the children and us adults a visual of the energy of nature to constantly bring forth life out of that which seems dead. We use these visuals to give the children an image of the resurrection. The new life of Easter came from the death on Good Friday. And the children ask, "How can that be?" And our answer is, "I can't explain it. But I also can't explain how a butterfly comes from a cocoon, how a little chick comes from an egg, and how a green frond comes from a hapu'u. All I know is that these things happen; beautiful new life comes from that which seems dead."

This is a great message for kids. And this reality is the basic foundation of our Christian belief. But, as adults, we take that basic belief to a deeper level. We are not exempt from the human condition. Regardless of whether we are daily, weekly, monthly, or yearly church goes we all experience the same human realities of sickness, personal and family stress, financial difficulties, injuries, and, ultimately, death. The point is not whether we will face these conditions of human life; the point is HOW we face them. We do it either with a "woe is me" attitude, sinking us into deeper stress and aimless wandering or we face the uncomfortable and stressful realities of our life with a belief that someday, somehow, our God will make something beautiful out of that which is ugly today.

Our parish of Malia Puka O Kalani is a beacon of Easter belief to those of us who are parishioners and, hopefully, to all who live in Keaukaha. Through our worship, through our service, through our faith formation we proclaim to ourselves and to our community that Malia is a people who live the Easter belief. We are on a journey which we cannot fully explain, but believe.
