**Readings for Next Week, 6<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter – Cycle C**

**1<sup>st</sup> Reading – Acts 15:1-2, 22-29:** Last week we heard of the end of Saint Paul’s first missionary journey. Today we hear of the Council of Jerusalem.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Reading – Revelation 21:10-14, 22-23:** Last week we heard the beginning of John’s description of the Heavenly Jerusalem, we now continue with that description. We must remember that it was Jesus’ mission to go to the earthly Jerusalem to offer His sacrifice; so that we could find the path which we must follow to reach the Heavenly Jerusalem and dwell with Him forever.

**Gospel – John 14:23-29:** Having heard last week of Jesus giving us a new commandment, to love one another, we rejoin Jesus and the apostles at the Last Supper. Jesus is instructing His apostles of the things to come.
